## TEXAS BOAT DEALERS TO PRESENT SEN. JOHN CARONA AND REP. DAN FLYNN 2013 LONE STAR AWARD FOR LEGISLATIVE EXCELLENCE

HOUSTON – The Boating Trades Association of Texas (BTAT) and Boating Trades Association of Metropolitan Houston (BTAMH) will present the 2013 Lone Star Awards for Legislative Excellence to State Senator John Carona (R-Dallas) and State Representative Dan Flynn (R-Van) for their legislative efforts on behalf of Texas recreational boating during the 83<sup>nd</sup> Legislative Session.
